MOTION TO SUBGRANT CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS



Danbury Schools Superintendent Cari Buehler extended thanks to Council for this partnership between the village and school to provide an air filtration and ionization system that will aid in protecting students, staff and visitors alike from the coronavirus.
