HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE - May 4 & September 7

- Accepting fluorescent/CFL bulbs and household batteries household batteries can only be accepted at this collection. •
- All automotive fluids & fuels, hand-held propane cylinders, motor oil, marine & auto flares. •
- Household cleaners, household pesticides/herbicides/fungicides/insecticides, inhalers & used cooking oil. •
- All paints, wood stains, aerosols, primers, thinners, strippers, sealers, tars, adhesives and coatings
- For instructions to dispose of latex paint properly at your home, contact the District's main office.
- Bring in your old mercury thermometer and exchange it for a free digital thermometer.
- Fluids will not be accepted in containers larger than 5 gallons.

TELEVISIONS & ELECTRONICS - May 11 & September 28 ATTENTION: NO LONGER ACCEPTING ANY TYPE OF CONSOLE OR PROJECTION SCREEN TV's.



- Accepting only standard glass tube televisions. The District will CHARGE to recycle glass tube TV's.
- TV's 24" or less \$5.00

- TV's 25" & larger \$7.00
- NO CHARGE for Electronics (e.g. LCD/LED or Plasma TV's, computers, CD/DVD players, stereos)

Ottawa County Only: June 8 APPLIANCES -Ottawa, Sandusky & Seneca Counties: September 21

- Any appliance or household object made primarily of steel including grills, mowers, microwaves, etc.
- No televisions, computers, plastic fans or vacuum cleaners, etc. .
- Refrigerators with food inside will not be accepted •
- Units containing freon will be accepted at no charge •

FARM TIRES - Pre-register Monday, August 12 until Friday, August 23

- Pre-register by calling the District's main office at 1-888-850-7224. Date & location will be provided at this time. •
- Prior to calling, know the quantity and height of the tires you would like to recycle. Tires will be accepted on or off the rim. There will be a charge to recycle farm tires.
- Implement tires up to 36" \$1.00 each •
 - Tires 37" 60" **\$10.00** each
 - Tires 61" & larger **\$15.00** each

NO DEALERS OR AGRI-BUSINESSES. •

RESIDENTIAL TIRES - October 19

- Limit of 10 tires per resident
- Car and small truck tires \$1.00 each •
- Accepting tires on or off the rim •
- Racing tires \$3.00 each Limit 10 per resident

ABSOLUTELY NO SEMI TIRES or TRACTOR TIRES - Call the District office for disposal options
