

**ORDINANCE NO. 1-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-2020  
SETTING 2021 WAGE RATES FOR EMPLOYEES IN THE VILLAGE OF  
MARBLEHEAD TO RETURN THE FISCAL OFFICER POSITION TO PART-TIME  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Marblehead last authorized employee pay rates with Ordinance No. 10-2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Finance Committee determined that there were sufficient funds available to provide pay increases for 2021 to most of the positions held by Village employees and to make the Fiscal Officer position full time; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 10-2020, in Section 14, made the Fiscal Officer's position a full-time position; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council has decided to change the Fiscal Officer position back to part-time status beginning the date the original change took place, January 3, 2021.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That the Street Commissioner/Maintenance Supervisor be paid \$25.35 per hour.

SECTION 2. That the Chief of Police be paid \$27.03 per hour.

SECTION 3. That the Police Sergeant be paid \$24.79 per hour.

SECTION 4. That full-time Police Officers be paid \$20.27 per hour.

SECTION 5. That part-time Police Officers be paid \$17.34 per hour.

SECTION 6. That the Chief Operating Engineer (C.O.E.) of the Water Works (minimum of a Class No. 3 Certificate) be paid \$28.91 per hour.

SECTION 7. That the Assistant C.O.E. (minimum of a Class No. 2 Certificate) be paid \$26.52 per hour.

SECTION 8. That an Operating Engineer II (O.E. II) (minimum of a Class No. 2 Certificate) be paid \$22.51 per hour.

SECTION 9. That an Operating Engineer I (O.E. I) (minimum of a Class No. 1 Certificate) be paid \$21.40 per hour.

SECTION 10. That a Water Works Operator in training be paid \$20.27 per hour.

SECTION 11. That a part-time, non-certified Water Works employee be paid \$14.36 per hour.

SECTION 12. That one part-time seasonal Park Maintenance employee scheduled to work an average of 25 hours per week, not to exceed 39 hours in any workweek or a maximum of 850 hours per year be paid \$14.28 per hour.

SECTION 13. That two part-time Street/Maintenance employees be paid \$15.30 per hour based on an average of 24 hours per week, not to exceed 39 hours in any workweek or a maximum of 1348 hours per year.

SECTION 14. That the part-time Fiscal Officer be paid \$25.91 per hour based on an average of 32 hours per week, not to exceed 39 hours in any workweek. The Fiscal Officer shall be paid from the Water Revenue Fund for hours worked for the water department and from the General Fund for all other hours worked as indicated on the bi-weekly time sheet.

SECTION 15. That the part-time Billing/Records Clerk, working under supervision of the Fiscal Officer, be paid \$18.77 per hour based on an average of 32 hours per week, not to exceed 39 hours in any workweek. The Billing/Records clerk shall be paid from the Water Revenue Fund for hours worked for the water department and from the General Fund for all other hours worked as indicated on the bi-weekly time sheet.


SECTION 16. That the part-time Zoning Inspector/Fiscal Assistant be paid \$18.87 per hour based on an average of 25 hrs. per week, not to exceed 39 hours in any workweek or a maximum of 1560 hours annually. The Zoning Inspector/Fiscal Assistant wages shall be apportioned between Zoning (60%) and Fiscal Assistant (40%) in the percentages indicated each pay period.

SECTION 17. That overtime be paid to appropriate employees according to the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act at a rate of one and one-half times their calculated hourly rate only for time worked beyond forty (40) hours per standard workweek.


SECTION 18. That Ordinance No. 10-2020 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 19. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Marblehead, and for the further reason that the pay raises need to be put into effect with the pay period that begins January 3, 2021, and therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
