

ORDINANCE NO. 2, 2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2017 TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2017 the Council of the Village of Marblehead adopted as an emergency measure Ordinance No. 1, 2017 titled An Ordinance to Make Appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of The Village of Marblehead, State of Ohio, During the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2017 and Declaring an Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer has advised the Council it is necessary to amend Section 19 titled the Water Repair and Improvement Fund of Ordinance No. 1 of 2017 to correct a typographical error in the original Appropriations Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 19 as well as the Total All Appropriations of Ordinance No. 1, 2017 titled An Ordinance to Make Appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of The Village of Marblehead, State of Ohio, During the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2017 and Declaring an Emergency hereby is amended as follows:

That there be appropriated from the **WATER REPAIRS & IMPROVEMENTS FUND:**

Supplies and Materials	\$	50,000.00	
Capital Outlay	\$	52,529.18

Section 2. Section 19 of Ordinance No. 1 of 2017 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.


