

ORDINANCE NO. 4-2020

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 5-2019
PROVIDING FOR A PAY INCREASE AND SETTING 2020 WAGE RATES FOR
CERTAIN POLICE POSITIONS IN THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the resignation of the Chief of Police has resulted in the need to appoint an Interim Chief; and

Whereas, in order to appoint an Interim Police Chief. The Village of Marblehead must create the position of Interim Police Chief and establish a wage for that position; and

WHEREAS, other staff openings on the Village police force have resulted in the need for Council to increase the number of hours worked by seasonal Police Officers;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the position of Interim Police Chief is hereby created and authorized.

Section 2. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 5-2019 be amended as follows:

That the Chief of Police and Interim Chief of Police be paid \$26.50 per hour.

Section 3. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 5-2019 be amended to permit part-time seasonal Police Officers to work up to 24 hours per week and read as follows:


That part-time seasonal Police Officers scheduled to work up to 24 hours per week for not more than 20 weeks be paid \$15.12 per hour.

Section 4. That the former Section 2 and Section 5 of the Village of Marblehead Ordinance No. 5-2019 be repealed and of no further effect.

Section 5. This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Marblehead, and further for the reason the Police Department cannot adequately perform its functions without the creation of and expansion of the afore mentioned positions, and therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
