

ORDINANCE NO. 8-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7-2020 TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on November 11, 2020 the Council of the Village of Marblehead adopted as an emergency measure Ordinance No. 7-2020 entitled An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance No. 1-2020 and Ordinance No. 2-2020 and Adopting Appropriations for Current Expenses and Other Expenditures of the Village of Marblehead, State of Ohio, During the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2020 to Add the Coronavirus Relief Fund and Declaring an Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2020 the Village received an additional \$5,895.45 from the Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Marblehead Village Council will use \$812.53 of these funds to reimburse expenses incurred by the Village due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as authorized in section 5001 of the CARES Act and subgrant the remaining \$5,082.92 to Danbury Local Schools for allowable expenses incurred due to the COVID-19 health emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, OTTAWA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 7-2020 entitled “An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance No. 1-2020 and Ordinance No. 2-2020 and Adopting Appropriations for Current Expenses and Other Expenditures of the Village of Marblehead, State of Ohio, During the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2020 to Add the Coronavirus Relief Fund and Declaring an Emergency is hereby amended as follows:

Additional Appropriation:

That there be appropriated from the **CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND:**



That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately appropriate money to ensure the additional revenue is used by December 31, 2020, WHEREFORE, THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
