RESOLUTION NO. 5-2020

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A K9 FUND TO RECEIVE DONATIONS
AND PAY EXPENSES TO SUPPORT THE POLICE K9 UNIT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Village of Marblehead established a Police K9 Unit on April 24, 2019; and

WHEREAS, there have been offers to donate money for expenses to support the K9 unit; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Marblehead needs to create a separate fund to segregate and properly disburse K9 donations.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARBLEHEAD, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That fund number 2901 titled K9 Fund is hereby established as a special revenue fund to receive donations to the Marblehead Police Department K9 unit.

SECTION 2. That donations deposited into the K9 Fund will be used at the direction of the Chief of Police for expenses associated with the K9 unit.

SECTION 3. This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Marblehead, and for the further reason that the Village can deposit donations, and therefore this Resolution shall go into immediate effect.
